Basis for this presentation

These encompass everything from the homepage to the initscripts to our server repository management tools. 

How to get involved

- Learn GIT
- Clone your favorite project's repository
- Dig into the code
- Find something you want to fix and fix it!
- Submit a patch using git format-patch
- Congrats, you are a contributor



How it really works

- You submit a patch but no one looks at it
 - Ping it or ask who is in charge of the project
- Your patch gets rejected
 - We've all had this happen before. Don't take it personally and resubmit with requested fixes
- You don't know where to start
 - Ask either in IRC or on a relevant mailing list



Not a great coder?

- Translations
 - Both pacman and the AUR are localized
- Bug triage
 - Assigning bugs to package maintainers, making sure they have enough info, cleaning up the trash
- Wiki editors
- Making sure the wiki articles are helpful and clear arch con 2010

Ideas for things to do

- Namcap
 - Add more rules and checks
 - Make it faster and betterer
 - Migrate to Python 3
- Web stuff
 - Figure out a better way to deploy design changes across all major sites
 - Deploy a better full text search engine for the BBS and wiki



Ideas for things to do

- Archweb
 - Integrate mirror check into main site
 - Add more geolocation/location-aware stuff
 - Localize it?
- Build server
 - Work with Daniel Griffiths on PKGBUILD.com
 - Get a fully automated build system working
